You have been ordered to cooperate and participate in **Thinking for a Change** (T4C) in the Juvenile Court of _______, County and/or by your Department of Juvenile Justice Probation Officer. Successful completion of the approximately 13-week course, Thinking for a Change, is a condition of your supervision order. You are hereby given notice to attend this program beginning *Wednesday, August 24th, 2016 at 6:00 pm.* On this date we will have an orientation meeting with facilitators from T4C, youth, and their parent/legal guardian. <u>A</u> <u>parent/legal guardian must attend with the youth to this meeting only.</u> The meeting should last approximately 1 hour, and will be the only meeting in which a parent/legal guardian must attend. At orientation we will discuss T4C rules, expectations of the youth, graduation requirements, the T4C schedule, and answer any questions you may have.

Orientation and subsequent T4C classes will be held at {NAME OF LOCATION}. The address is {XXX}. T4C classes will be regularly be held from 6:00 pm to 7:30 pm on most Tuesdays and Thursdays through November 2016. An exact schedule will be distributed and discussed at the orientation meeting.
