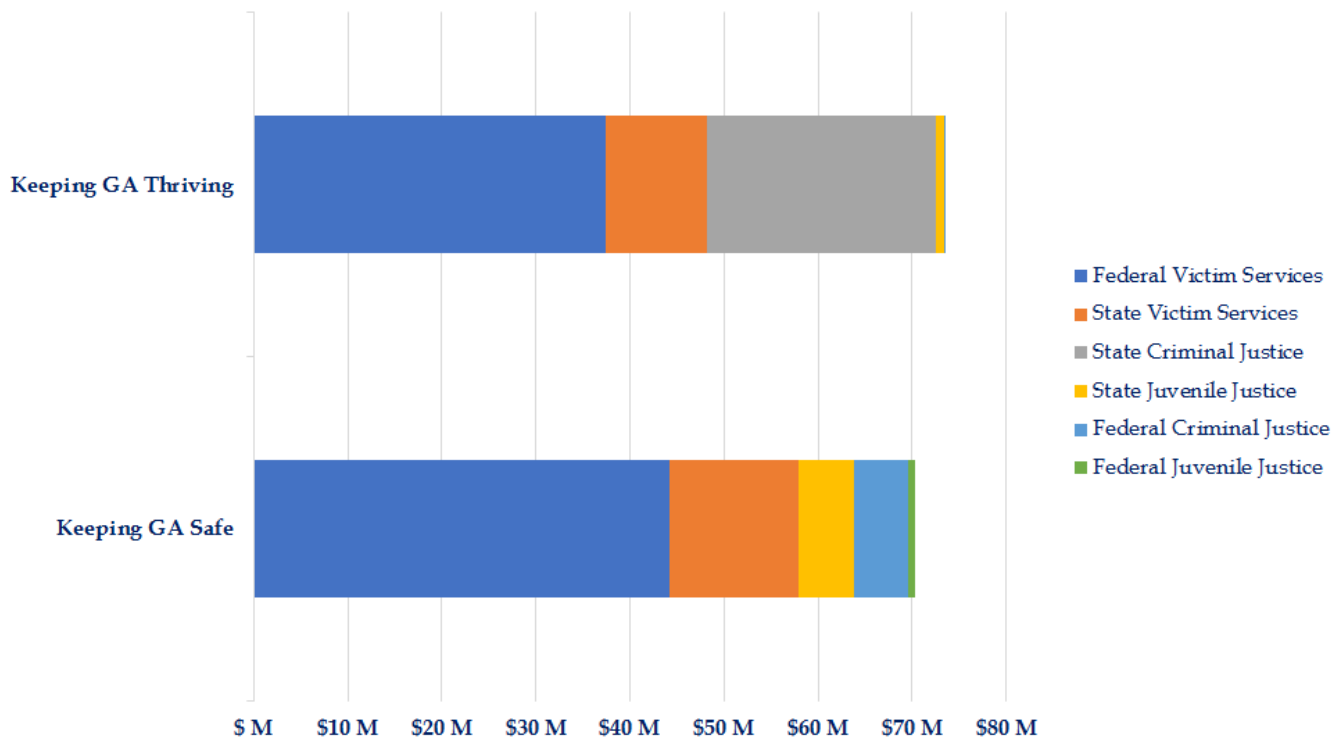

\$1 = \$124

For every dollar invested in administrative operations, CJCC puts \$124 to work across Georgia.

1 = \$1.4M

For every 1 full-time employee, CJCC puts \$1.4M into local agencies for direct service provision.



\$1 = \$2.47

For every dollar spent on criminal justice innovation, CJCC distributed \$2.47 for victim services.
